This big yellow tiger found his forever home with a loving owner and is now the official greeter to anyone who comes by.



Which Type of Cat Litter is Best?

There are a lot of cat litters out there, and deciding which to use starts with whether you – and your cat – like clumping or non-clumping litter. The most important characteristic is that your cat likes it and will use it. Most adult cats can use clumping litter safely so if your cat is happy and remains healthy, don't rock the boat!

Situations in which you might choose a non-clumping litter:

- Young kittens
- Cats or caretakers with asthma
- Cats that play with or eat their litter
- Long-haired cats

Use Caution!

Clumping litters do have their downsides, and are not the best fit for every cat. If your cat swallows any litter, either directly or in grooming, the moisture in the gastrointestinal tract can trigger it to clump, which can lead to irritation or even obstruction in the GI tract. The same thing happens if your dog gets in the litter box.
